OVERVIEW



APOLLO is the «swiss army knife» for everyone who need to record his voice or an acoustic instrument to his computer. The integrated USB interface is equipped with premium quality A/D converters ensuring top performances ever.


Thanks to the Headphone Out you can listen what you're recording in realt-time so you can adjust the Volume and finally get your audio file without any distortion or noise. With the original Tripod you can place the APOLLO in every surface adjusting the height via the rotating swivel.








OPERATION



FRONT PANEL

In the front panel you find the knob (1) to adjust the overall Volume of the Headphone.

In the center of the Pot there is the MUTE button (2); it mutes the signal from the Mic to the Computer. Above the Knob there is a 3-color LED (3), it lights up BLUE to indicates power, AMBER if the MIC is in MUTE mode and it flashes RED when the signal is clipping.



BACK PANEL

In the back panel you find the USB connection(5). Use the supplied USB cable to connect the MIC to your computer.

NOTE: the device is "Plug'n'play" so you don't need additional driver if you connect it to a PC or a MAC.

Above the USB connector there is the Headphone Out connector (4). Plug your headphone to this mini jack (stereo 3,5mm) and listen what are you recording in real-time.
